1 Startup

2 Identification

Review of your business or product, or parts thereof, to identify the "low-hanging fruit." We conduct benchmarking and relate it to your current green accounting.

3 Workshop

Half to full-day presentations and workshop to prepare employees for green optimization of products and machinery, starting from the idea and design phase. Using your own products and workflows as a starting point helps kickstart a culture and anchor the idea for future use.

4 Optimization

Working with a specific product or machine in your collaboration with the aim of reducing the green footprint. Development of a plan for how it can be implemented in the future, based on input from the workshop.

5 Integration

Complete integration and embedding into your business so that future products become as green as possible. General guidelines that make green design a natural and integrated part of the workplace workflow. Visualization of the green benefits.
